

Stanley Park has implemented the following COVID-19 virus precautions:

1. Stanley Park is closed for all activities but open for people to come and walk in the Park or the Sanctuary, at their own risk.
2. Our gates and parking lots will remain closed. When parking outside the park, please park wisely and for safety reasons and any emergencies, please do not park in front of any of our gates.
3. The Park Administration and Maintenance offices will be closed to the public March 24<sup>th</sup> - April 6<sup>th</sup>.
4. The restrooms and play-structures are closed until the State of Emergency is lifted in order to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.
