

Stanley Park will be opening on Tuesday May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020:

1. Stanley Park will open for passive recreation only, with consideration for State and Local Social Distancing guidelines.
2. Pedestrian access will continue through various entry points.
3. The Stanley Park entrance (Gate 3) on Kensington Road and the Granville Rd. entrance (Gate 5) will be open for parking only between the hours of 8:00am – 5:00pm. Gate 3 will be open with a 100 car limited parking, for now. This will allow patrons to safely park their vehicles when enjoying the Park.
4. Parking will be limited to the parking lots and marked parking spots. Please do not park on the grass or along the roadways. Handicap parking spaces are available in both parking lots.
  - a. There are limited Partner in Preservation parking spaces reserved for Stanley Park members in the Rose Garden parking lot (Kensington Rd entrance). These spaces are available to members on a first-come, first-served basis. Please be considerate of Park Rangers who need to monitor parking and entrances.
5. The tennis courts, basketball courts, play-structures, playground, the athletic fields for group athletics and picnic areas will remain closed at this time.
6. There will be limited restroom availability.
7. Stanley Park Main Office and Development Office will be closed to the public, but staff are available between 8:00am – 4:00pm, Monday through Friday, by phone 413-568-9312 or email. If you need to conduct in-person business with the offices, please call and we will direct you through our social distancing procedures.
  - a. In the event of an emergency while the Park is open, the Park Ranger direct line is: (413) 297-9456.
8. We ask all Park visitors to be thoughtful and mindful of others while visiting Stanley Park and use all precautions by following “Social Distancing” guidelines.
